City Council Proceedings
November 8, 2022

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Tilden met in regular session on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 at 7:30pm at the Tilden Council Chambers. Notice of the meeting was given by publication in The Tilden Citizen/Meadow Grove News on October 26, 2022 and by posting at four locations within the city.

- (1) Mayor Leo Botsford opened the meeting at 7:30 pm and the Clerk recorded the proceedings.
- (2) Declaration of open meetings act.
- (3) ROLL CALL: Mayor Leo Botsford. Council Members: Allen Smidt, Travis Rutjens, Lisa Meyer, Darrell Wyatt, Patricia Decker, Molly Navratil.
- (4) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
- (5) MAYOR'S OPEN DISCUSSION – Mayor Botsford wanted to thank Antelope County Sheriff's department for the use of a vehicle while the Tilden police vehicle was out of commission for repairs.
- (6) CONSENT AGENDA – Smidt moved to approve the consent agenda, seconded by Meyer. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Meyer, Rutjens, Smidt. No – None. Approved.
- (7) REPORTS BY CITY DEPARTMENTS-Written reports are kept on file in the City office and are available for public viewing.
- (8) The 2022-1 Street Improvement hearing was opened at 7:34 pm.
- (9) The 2022-1 Street Improvement hearing was closed at 7:35 pm. Resolution 2022-10-01 – A resolution of the City of Tilden, Nebraska to proceed with Street Improvement District 2022-1. Motion was made by Wyatt, seconded by Smidt to approve. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Rutjens, Meyer, Wyatt, Decker, Navratil. No – None. Approved.
- (10) TYMC – Tanner Magwire and Alan Rutjens was present to notify the Council that soon after Thanksgiving they will be placing the Christmas tree at the intersection of Madison and 2nd Street. Also, the design for the memorial near the welcome to Tilden sign was shown. Motion made by Decker, seconded by Meyer to close 2nd Street from Center Street to Oak Street during the Christmas Stroll on December 3rd. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Meyer, Rutjens, Smidt. No - None. Approved.
- (11) INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT – Motion made by Meyer, seconded by Wyatt to approve. RCV: Yes – Navratil, Decker, Wyatt, Meyer, Rutjens, Smidt. No – None. Approved.
- (12) WATER USAGE – Information from the Lower Elkhorn NRD only.
- (13) SDL – Motion made by Smidt to approve the SDL requested by Thriftway Market, seconded by Meyer. RCV: Yes – Rutjens, Decker, Navratil, Smidt, Meyer, Wyatt. No – None. Approved.
- (14) BANNERS – Motion made by Decker, seconded by Wyatt to explore options and spend up to \$2,000 from keno funds to purchase new Welcome to Tilden banners. RCV: Yes – Wyatt, Navratil, Decker, Meyer, Smidt, Rutjens. No – None. Approved.
- (15) EASEMENT – No action taken.
- (16) PROJECTS – No action taken.
- (17) SNOW REMOVAL – Still looking for interested parties to remove snow at the clinic and location of the old hospital, possibly several times a day if continuous snow.
- (18) NUISANCE – Updates given on current nuisance situations.

With no further business to come before the council, Wyatt made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Rutjens. Meeting was adjourned at 8:37 pm.
