## About the Tilden Youth Survey


The Tilden youth survey is an online tool to measure perceptions of current Tilden high school students. They are asked various questions about their impressions of Tilden, future career plans and interest in remaining or returning to Tilden.

## Tilden Youth Survey Process

In Tilden, the youth survey was given to all students in grades 9 – 12 at the local high school. A total of 55 youth completed the survey.


## Interest in Educational Courses

The youth were first asked what out-of-school education courses would be of interest to them. Most youth (55%) are interested in both entrepreneurship training and leadership training. Just over one-half (55%) are interested in entrepreneurship training that includes hands-on learning experiences as well as leadership training for personal growth and community opportunities. One individual suggested aviation as another educational course of interest.




## Future Plans

When all students were asked about their plans after graduation, most youth plan to further their education. Just over one-half (53%) plan to attend a four-year college or university. And, over one-third (36%) plan to go to a two-year trade or technical school or community college. Just over one-quarter (26%) plan work for someone else and 15 percent plan to join the military.




When responses from just juniors and seniors are examined, 42% plan to go to a four-year college or university and 40% plan to attend a two-year school. Twenty-one percent would like to work for someone else.



## Community Impressions

Six in ten youth rate Tilden as either a good (31%) or excellent (29%) place to live.

When asked what they see as Tilden’s strengths, 53 youth responded. The responses included mentions of the following themes:



- Close, tight knit or caring community (30)
- community amenities (5)
- people (5)
- school (3)
- strong community (3)
- safe community (3)
- family friendly (2)
- and other (9) - Other responses mentioned nice community, clean, great community, community structures and negative responses.

The complete list of responses is included in Appendix Table 1.

When asked what amenities they would most like to see added or improved, 53 responses were received. The top response categories included:

- more restaurants (11)
- new pool or improvements (10)
- activities for teens or youth (7)
- theater or drive-in theater (6)
- other responses (15) including gas station (2), new gym, updating the bowling alley, and roads.
- auditorium (4)
- more housing (3)
- a new track (3)


The complete list of responses is included in Appendix Table 2.

Students were then asked if they were the mayor of Tilden what they would do to provide a good life for its citizens and 47 youth responded. The top themes of responses included:


- fix roads and streets (10)
- more community activities (8)
- more stores or businesses (8)
- more restaurants or food choices (6)
- other (12). Some of the other responses included: listening to the citizens (2), don't know (2), and better school.
- more entertainment options (4)
- maintaining or improving the community appearance (3)
- new pool or improvements to pool (3)

The complete list of responses is included in Appendix Table 3.

The youth were given a list of items and were asked which they would like to see included in a community center if one were to be built. At least four in ten said they would definitely like to see the following included in the community center: fitness center with equipment (67%), other (62%), teen lounge center (56%), conference/buffet area (48%), and multipurpose venue area (43%). Some of the other options listed include: pool, food place, skate park, and movie theater or arcade.



The youth were next asked what priority level they would rate various community projects. Most youth rated a sports complex/recreation facilities (78%) and a new community center (61%) as a high or the highest priority. Just under one-half (49%) rate downtown revitalization as at least a high priority.




Youth were next asked what types of community events they would like to see in Tilden. Out of the 40 responses received, the top categories included: sporting events (12), music (concerts and dances) (6), children’s activities (4), more events like Prairie Days (4), and food events (3). Other responses (17) included items such as parades, teen activities, and tree lighting. The complete listing is found in Appendix Table 4.

### Reasons to Stay in or Return to Tilden


The youth were then given a list of reasons and were asked to say if each was a major reason, a minor reason or not a reason they would stay in or return to the Tilden area. Many youth say the following are major reasons: connections to friends (52%), cost of living (45%), a good place to raise children (44%), I grew up there (44%), and family ties (43%).

Next, students were asked if they would return to the Tilden area to live in the future if quality career or business ownership opportunities were available. Approximately one-third (33%) said it is likely that they would return to the area in the future. Just over two in ten said it was very likely they would return to the area in the future (23%) and one in ten said it was likely (10%).


### Likelihood of Returning to Tilden Area



When asked what type of jobs/opportunities would encourage them to stay or return to Tilden to work, the top responses included:

- healthcare occupations (9)
- professional occupations (6)
- trades occupations (5)
- teaching positions (4)
- more businesses or jobs (3)
- service occupations (2)
- other (9) including bigger pool and jobs with livable wages.

Next, they were asked if they would consider buying or starting a business in or around Tilden someday. Almost one-third (32%) said they would consider buying or starting a business.




The types of businesses they are interested in starting include:

- healthcare (5)
- food related (3)
- not sure (2)
- retail businesses (1)
- service businesses (1)
- trades businesses (1)
- professional businesses (1)

Next, they were asked if there are additional lifestyle or job requirements that would be necessary for them to consider staying in or moving back to the Tilden area. The responses included: none (11), don't know, jobs/businesses (5), community amenities (2) and other.

## Where Students Like to Learn about Community Information

The youth were asked how they would like to learn about community information in Tilden. The top choices include: Facebook (65%), website (52%), Snapchat (42%), Instagram (38%) and Twitter (27%).



## Demographics

Finally, students were asked what year in school they are. The responses were:

- Freshmen (7)
- Sophomores (10)

- Juniors (9)
- Seniors (29).
