City Council Proceedings  
February 10, 2026

The Mayor and City Council of the City of Tilden met in regular session on Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 7:30pm at the Tilden Council Chambers. Notice of the meeting was given by publication in The Tilden Citizen/Meadow Grove News on January 28, 2026 and by posting at four locations within the city.

(1) Mayor Tom Nelson opened the regular meeting at 7:30 pm and the Clerk recorded the proceedings.

(2) Declaration of open meetings act.

(3) ROLL CALL: Mayor Tom Nelson. Council Members Al Smidt, Halle Hart, Allen Miller, Darrell Wyatt. Absent – Lisa Meyer, Carla Loop.

(4) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

(5) MAYOR’S OPEN DISCUSSION – Mayor Nelson wanted to congratulate all the Elkhorn Valley wrestlers and basketball teams on their successes.

(6) CONSENT AGENDA – Motion made by Hart, seconded by Miller to approve the consent agenda. RCV: Yes – Hart, Miller, Wyatt, Smidt. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved.

(7) REPORTS BY CITY DEPARTMENTS-Written reports are kept on file in the City office and are available for public viewing.

(8) ORDINANCE 562 – Public hearing was opened 7:33 pm; motion made by Miller, seconded by Wyatt. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Wyatt, Miller, Hart. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved. Mayor Nelson explained the purpose of the ordinance in amending land use for mini-storage in certain zoned areas. No public comments. Motion made by Miller, seconded by Hart to close the hearing at 7:35 pm. RCV: Yes – Hart, Miller, Wyatt, Smidt. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved. Motion made by Hart, seconded by Miller to introduce Ordinance 562, waive the 3 required reading and provide for publication in pamphlet form and passage. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Wyatt, Miller, Hart. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved.

(9) PRAIRIE DAYS – Motion made by Wyatt, seconded by Hart to approve \$6700 from keno funds to provide for new hanging baskets and flowers for downtown during Prairie Days. RCV: Yes – Hart, Miller, Wyatt, Smidt. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved.

(10) LAND PURCHASE – Attorney Brogan will contact the selling agency regarding the City’s interest in purchasing a portion of land to the South of the city cemetery.

(11) COMPLETE PEST ELIMINATION – Motion made by Smidt, seconded by Miller to approve the 2026 contract. RCV: Yes – Hart, Miller, Wyatt, Smidt. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved.

(12) SHOP – Tabled until next month.

(13) ACES – Motion made by Hart to approve a contract in the amount of \$7500 for the design of the baseball field including grading plan, site layout, walks, bleacher area, drainage and fencing within 30 days, seconded by Smidt. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Wyatt, Miller, Hart. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved.

(14) GENERATOR – Motion made by Hart, seconded by Miller to approve the specs and authorizing ACES to bid the project. RCV: Yes – Hart, Miller, Wyatt, Smidt. No – None. Absent – Meyer, Loop. Approved.

(15) SDL – Motion made by Miller, seconded by Smidt to approve both requests by Players Club for March 20 and 21. RCV: Yes – Smidt, Wyatt, Miller, Hart. No – None. Absent – Loop, Meyer. Approved.

(16) NUISANCE PROPERTIES – Several properties discussed and letters will be sent by Attorney Brogan.

With no further business to come before the council, Miller made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Wyatt. Meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm.
